Over the past 30 years, the college has been a beacon of guiding light to the community and has nurtured several thousand responsible citizens to this country. Our journey, from being an institution imparting education to 1st generation learners in Murugan Pudur village from 1994 to become a centre of academic excellence with a rigorous academic and research ecosystem in this digital age. On this 30th year, we pay homage to the visionary founder of this institution late Thiru P.R. Natarajan Ayya, who made the women education in reality. Our Secretary & Correspondent Thiru P.N.Venkatachalam's service for the smooth functioning of the institution is noteworthy. He is the follower of the footsteps of his father by playing a creditable role to achieve the objective of quality education to women hailing from rural areas. The founder Principal and current CEO Mrs. Jagatha Lakshamanan is the embodiment of energy and strength of the institution.

In this annual report, I would like to present a brief summary of our achievements on the academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities for the academic year 2023-24. Seminars, Webinars, Workshops, Conferences and invited lectures are a routine feature of the PKR intellectual climate. Theoretical knowledge is fostered by hands-on experience in the form of field visits/ educational trips / practical training organized for both the students and faculty. Our College was re-accredited with Grade "A" by NAAC in the Academic Year 2023-24.

It would not be an understatement to mention that our college has channelized its efforts towards excellence in performance, self governance and enhancement in quality education since the grant of autonomy in 2017-18. By virtue of the autonomous status, the college has introduced students' centric courses following Outcome Based Education.
